

LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

As I wrap up my first year as Executive Director of Teton Valley Skijoring, I'm both proud and energized. The 2025 event and planning period was a season of tremendous growth and forward momentum. We welcomed nearly 5,000 attendees to the Grand Showdown, saw visitors from 34 states and Canada, and achieved a 1.7x increase in attendance over the previous year. Spectators and competitors alike rated the experience highly, and 92% of competitors plan to return — a testament to the quality of the event and the sense of belonging it fosters.

Behind the scenes, we made significant progress, too. This year, we implemented key systems and operational improvements that streamlined our planning, strengthened our partnerships, and laid the groundwork for sustainable growth. These changes not only improved the experience for participants and volunteers, but also created space to dream even bigger.

We couldn't have done any of it without the incredible support of our sponsors and the 150+ community volunteers who helped bring it all to life. This event is a massive production, requiring months of planning, hundreds of hands, and the generous backing of businesses and donors. From course building and start gate wrangling to competitor registration and ring setting, every detail was powered by people who believe in what this event means for Teton Valley and for the sport of skijoring. That spirit of collaboration is what makes this more than a race; it makes it a community tradition.

Looking ahead, we're excited to continue this work. Our goal is to make the sport of skioring even bigger, better, and more accessible to everyone in the valley. Whether you're a longtime fan or new to the sport, there's a place for you at the starting line and we can't wait to welcome you!


